ICPA Qld Inc Policy Statements

BOARDING SCHOOLS and HOSTELS POLICY

To ensure the continuing involvement of boarding schools and hostels in providing living away from home facilities for geographically isolated children.

COMMUNICATIONS POLICY

To ensure that information and communication technology (ICT) is utilised to the best possible advantage for geographically isolated students.

CURRICULUM POLICY

That all children in Queensland receive a high standard curriculum, which will promote their development and ensure that they are well prepared for their present and future life roles.

DISTANCE EDUCATION POLICY

To ensure the delivery of the best possible educational service, to students who do not have daily face to face contact with their teacher, through the support of a decentralised distance education network.

EARLY CHILDHOOD POLICY

That an appropriate range of early childhood programs be available to support children and families who live in rural and remote areas.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY

The payment of allowances equal to the cost of gaining access to a continuing and appropriate education.

SCHOOLS POLICY (This policy includes RREAP)

To ensure the continuity of delivery of quality educational services to students in rural and remote schools and access to a broad range of subjects and school experiences to cater for the varying needs of isolated students.

SPECIFIC NEEDS POLICY

(Specific Needs includes students with disability, learning difficulties and/or gifted and talented students)

That adequate funding, facilities and support be available to enhance the educational requirements of students with specific needs who reside in regional, rural or remote areas.

TEACHER EDUCATION POLICY

That a positive attitude to teaching in isolated areas be encouraged in all teachers during pre-service training, supported later by induction and in-service programs.

TERTIARY, TRADE & TRAINING POLICY

That students in rural and remote areas have access to post compulsory educational options which will enable them to pursue the career path of their choice.

TRAVEL POLICY

The payment of travel allowances to parents of geographically isolated children to defray the cost of gaining access to educational services.
