EXPECTATIONS

Communications:

State Council 'talks' via email.

Respond to emails as
appropriate. Your opinion
matters and responses valued –
so hit reply all!

Teleconferences:

once a month for 1-1.5hrs

Branch Mentor:

the important link between State Council and our branches.

Portfolio Leader:

and a support person to another Portfolio Leader.
Liaise with relevant representatives appropriate to issues and motions relating to your Portfolio.

Work as part of a team of State
Councillors to support ICPA's goal for equity of access to education for all students who live in rural and remote Australia.

State Conference:

all State Councillors are expected to attend State Conference, which is held annually.

Federal Conference:

not required as a State
Councillor, but can attend on
behalf of your Branch

Face 2 Face meetings

meet 3 times a year for 2 days, coincides with start/end school term

Ask for help:

if you don't know, someone else on Council will!

Delegations:

allows Councillors to meet and discuss issues with politicians and government officials face to face. It is a great way to build rapport with decision makers.
