The 2022 "cuppa, cake and convo" in airconditioned comfort at Theodore Home and Garden Café seems a far cry from our district's first ICPA meeting in 1979 of the then Cracow-Eidsvold branch who met in the paddock by the side of the main (dirt) road 100km to the south. And yet, how different are we really? Those families in the late 70s harboured our same concerns about their own children not being able to access the accepted standard of education available to their urban counterparts and hoped to forge positive change through banding together and raising their voices.

When the Cracow school was closed down in the 90s and the Theodore (Acacia) bus run extended to Cracow, families utilising the Cracow bus run service eventually
