- Contributing to Federal Focus where applicable.
- Sending Pedals publisher mail export quarterly. Contribute when required.
- Assisting with Federal Conference data when required.
- Reporting to the Federal Council and attending meetings when required.
- Reporting membership numbers to councils quarterly.
