A \$500 Bursary to assist with tertiary study is available for 2024. This is made possible by donations from fundraising and membership.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligibility Criteria:

- The Bursary is available to students who are current or commencing studies at a University or VET course. This includes Apprentices.
- The applicant's parents MUST be current members of Kindon ICPA Branch.
- Applicants must be undertaking a Degree, Diploma or working towards a Certificate IV through an Apprenticeship.

Application Criteria:

Must include the following information -

- Cover page to include name and contact details address, phone number and email.
- Proof of entry into chosen course of study.
- A description of interests and achievements other than academic (sporting, cultural, community etc.)
- Brief statement explaining career goals and personal circumstances.
- An explanation on how the Bursary is to be spent. (University students may choose to pay for first semester books or fees, an apprentice may choose to pay for tools etc.)
- Proof of expenditure will be required.
- Profile photo of at least 1MB for promotional purposes.
- Applications must be submitted in <u>PDF format</u>.
