There were two new lines added, a specially designed cap for the Bourke conference and sock savers. The introduction of EFTPOS card facilities via 'Square' has facilitated direct online payments and assisted in managing stock levels. The reduction of stock has enabled merchandise to be contained to one large 25 kg suitcase, which will make it easier for traveling to conferences.
