GUIDELINES – 'Remote Concrete' Access Grant.

NT State ICPA offers the following grant proudly supported by: **Remote Concrete**

'Remote Concrete' Access Grant:

To help cover costs for requirements –

Educational, Licences & Training, such as:

- Educational costs for Events / Courses / Sport. eg: attending specialised training for chosen activity / sport / profession.
- Drivers Licence And Motorbike Licence
- MR, HR, MC Truck licence
- Machinery Licence ie. Grader, Fork Lift, Loader
- Trade School / Travel Costs (Other educational costs associated with attending courses for Trade)
- Other licences / tickets required to enter the workforce

- The **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** will be offered by NT State ICPA until the funds gifted by Remote Concrete (for the purpose of this Grant) are fully allocated to successful applicants.
- Age for applicants is 16 – 20 years (in that calendar year)

4 Panel Members:

At least 1 Representative from Remote Concrete (with no family members applying for the Access Grant)

At least 1 Representative from NT State ICPA member (with no family members applying for the Access Grant)

A maximum of 4 panel members total (from within ICPA / Remote Concrete) is required to sit on the **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant Panel**.

The Panel reserve the right not to award a **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** if they deem the applications have not met the criteria.

Applications:

Completed Application Form should be received by NT ICPA 31st October and include:

- One application per person per year.
- Applicants are able to apply for no more than two consecutive years. (However they can submit an application in the event no other Applications are received and can be then awarded)
- Name, DOB, and contact information.
- Bank Account Details (Account Name, BSB, Account Number, Name of Bank)
- Outline of Licence / Training / Educational Activity chosen by applicant.
- Approximate or actual cost of Licence / Training / Educational Activity and any other costs related to their chosen activity.
- If chosen activity is yet to occur, provide a plan outlining when and where activity is offered or undertaken and associated cost.
- Brief outline stating how the **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** would benefit the applicant; now and in the future. (To be published in the ICPA magazine and other media platforms on behalf of successful application)
- Applicants family must be a current ICPA member for at least 12 months.



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'Remote Concrete' Access Grant - Winner:

All applications to be considered by Panel.

The successful applicant to be announced by mid December (of that year)

A Certificate of the **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** will be presented to the successful applicant; signed by A representative of Remote Concrete and the NT State ICPA President.

Allocation of Access Grant funds:

Option 1) 4 x \$500 **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** on offer each year.

OR – depending on number of applications

Option 2) 2 x \$1000 **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** on offer each year.

Selecting option 1 or 2, will be at the discretion of the Panel Members.

Funds Payable:

Funds to be paid by the NT ICPA State Treasurer.

Funds paid to the successful applicant using the bank details provided in application.

Payment remittance must be sent to the applicant.

Grant Details:

This Grant was established in 2019.

The **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant** was generously funded by Owner / Director of Remote Concrete; Jared Baldwin.

Jared can appreciate and empathise the strain caused on a family to provide an education for their children while living in rural and remote Australia.

He has partnered with the NT ICPA to help reduce this burden by funding the **'Remote Concrete' Access Grant**.
