A wide array of trade displays will be open over the two days. Boarding schools, allied health groups, Telstra, and nbn Local are just some of the groups who will be available to meet with delegates. The Department of Education will also have an IT support desk on hand where a technician will run a health check over your device.

ICPA Qld is looking forward to spending time in Winton, hearing about both the triumphs and struggles of rural and remote education, and enjoying the hospitality of an iconic western Queensland town.
