## **COUNTRY AREAS PROGRAM**



## **POLICY:**

ICPA supports equity programs which improve educational participation and achievements of students disadvantaged by restricted access to social, cultural and educational activities and services as a result of their geographic isolation.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. The provision of adequate Commonwealth funding to allow CAP to continue.
- **2.** The supply of guidelines, recommendations and reports to all equity committees including ICPA and community members, charged with developing and implementing programs.
- **3.** Priority funding which recognises the extra costs associated with implementing innovative programs in isolated areas.
- **4.** Recognition that the Country Areas Program funding should be weighted more heavily for small and remote school communities, or where normal services are unavailable.
- **5.** Programs which place equal emphasis on students in all years K–12 unless specifically funded to address issues such as the years 11-12 retention rate.
- **6.** Continuation of the inter-systemic administration of funding and programs through community based regional committees, wherever this would be the most effective and appropriate structure.
- 7. Encouragement of community participation in local, regional and state committees with ICPA representation on all appropriate levels of management within the programs.
- **8.** Encouragement by the Commonwealth for State Education Departments and non-government systems to adopt and fund successful program initiatives which have become recognised as essential educational support services in rural schools.
- **9.** Encouragement of parents on local school based CAP committees by the CAP consultants and school Principals to participate in the formulation of network initiatives.
- **10.** Programmes that involve student participation in the network initiatives.
