

CURRICULUM



POLICY:

To ensure that geographically isolated children have access to an education at schools and in tertiary institutions that in terms of both quality and diversity of curriculum material provides an equal educational opportunity with their non-isolated counterparts.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To endeavour to keep members informed of curriculum outlines and changes when they happen.
2. To encourage members to contribute to the discussion and debate on curriculum development that takes place within the schools and community.
3. To liaise with the Board of Studies to keep it informed of the diverse needs of geographically isolated children so that these are taken into account when curriculum materials are being developed.
4. To liaise with and refer to the Centre for Learning Innovation (CLI) on Curriculum matters of concern to Distance Education Students, Supervisors and small isolated schools.
